
Bring your car with some candy in the trunk and park in the parking lot of the church as we participate in a venue for our local children to trick or treat safely.






<u>10/16</u> Fall Break—but we are going to meet. A surprise mystery event. More details to follow.


10/23 Pulse in Mission--A local mission event and lesson about <u>The Book</u>.


